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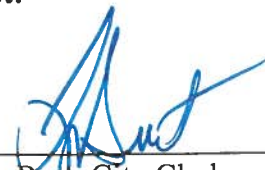

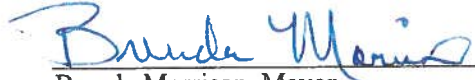
RESOLUTION TO approve continued retention pond grounds maintenance at the following locations only:

Nature Walk Subdivision

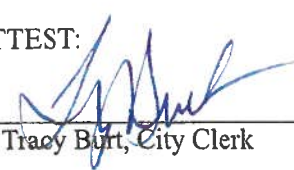

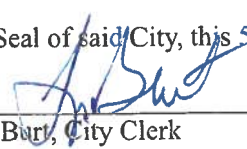

RESOLUTION NO. 09032024

**Resolution for Annual Transportation Plan Pursuant
to the Rebuild Alabama Act**

WHEREAS, the Alabama legislature in Act. No. 2019-2 adopted the Rebuild Alabama Act;

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act provides for an allocation among the municipalities of the state on the basis of the ratio of population of each municipality to the total population of all municipalities of the state a portion of the additional taxes levied under the Act to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvement, preservation and maintenance;

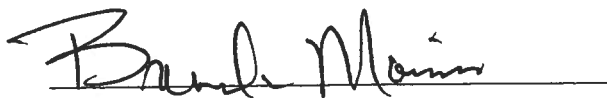
WHEREAS, the Act provides that the municipal governing body of the City of Vance shall adopt an annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31, 2023 which was done August 21, 2024 and it provided a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in 2023 based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund in which the additional revenue is deposited during the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Act further provides that any such funds shall be used only for the maintenance, improvement, replacement, and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the City of Vance and such other uses as are defined in the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of

Vance is now providing a detailed list of projects for which expenditures of \$102,500.00 (RAA Funds) are intended to be made in 2024/ 2025 based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund in which the additional revenue is deposited during the next fiscal year.
